OSI, is an online platform designed to help parents to learn tools and techniques to help their child (aged 5 to 12 years old) to overcome difficulties with worries/fears/anxiety.

We have had some amazing outcomes and feedback from families around their experience of OSI, which has supported parents/carers to support their child with a range of worries, such as worries related to going into school, bedtime fears, specific phobias e.g., dogs, insects, injections and many more. We want to see more families benefit from OSI and they will only know to contact us if you help us promote this.

The intervention is a combination of weekly calls with our service and online guidance. We aim to help parents/carers guide their young person to begin to feel braver and happier in overcoming their worry or fear using the OSI techniques. The interventions are part of our services offer so not available to all schools. For parents/carers to access this offer, they are required to email us to let us know they are interested and have read the information on our website. We will do the rest!
